Shaded trails wind along the creek, above the lake and through mature forests and across deep ravines. Trails are mostly double wide, moderate to rugged on a dirt surface with 1 brief road section. Out and back is approximately 8 miles or about a 3 hour ride.

The trail head has a shelter house, but there is no electric. A shower house with flush toilets is located nearby, but horses must remain on marked trails. Horses may be watered at the lake with caution, but only within the horse parking area and there is water on the trail at the creek crossing. You may want to bring water with you. The parking area is tight for large rigs. At this time parking is very limited, especially for large rigs. Large groups should contact A. J. Jolly Park to make arrangements for overflow parking. In order to record equine usage, please register each rider at the front gate.

For trail information or to see a map visit: <http://ajjollypark.com/> or call 859-635-4423. A. J. Jolly Park requires the purchase of a pass from the park office. A Day Pass is \$9.00. A Season Pass is \$17.00 for Campbell County residents and \$24.00 for non-county residents.

Restaurants and a convenient store are located approximately 1 mile from the Park. There is fishing, golfing, tennis, biking and a playground for those who do not ride horses.

RULES

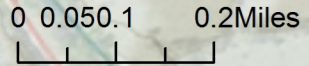
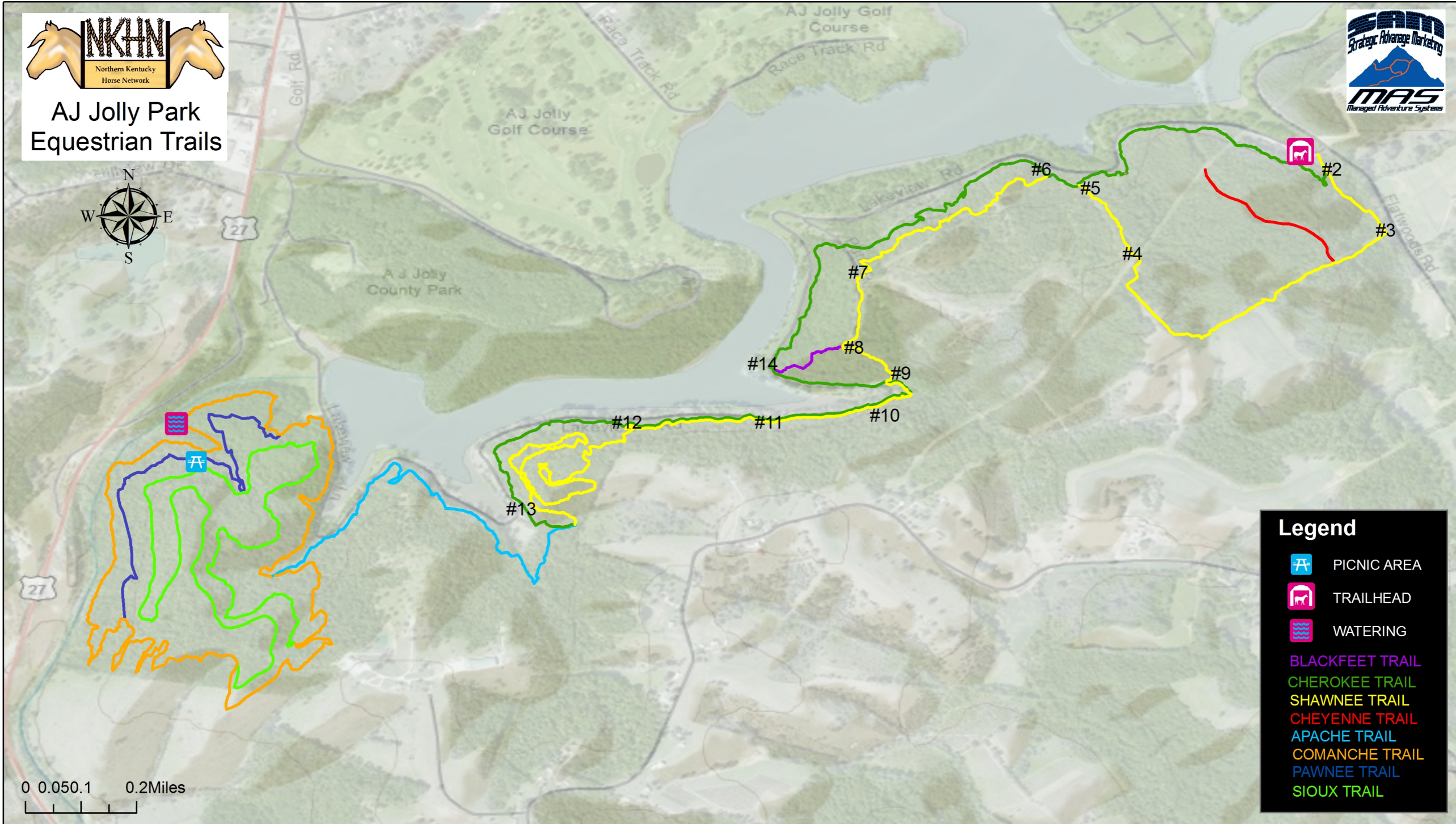
The A.J. Jolly Horse Trails are maintained by a Volunteer Trail Crew, organized through the Northern Kentucky Horse Network. To ensure access to the trails will continue for generations to come and to help maintain a sustainable trails system, please respect park rules and the land on which you ride.

- State Law Requires a Current Negative Coggins.
- Ride only on marked trails and do not ride onto private property or ride your horse to the lake.
- You may only water your horse at the lake next to the horse parking area. Water may be available at the creek crossing on the trail.
- During the dry season, you may want to bring water for your horses.
- Please do not litter.
- Please do not ride on the road unless marked with horseshoes.
- Please do not tie horses to trees.
- No alcohol.
- No smoking during dry conditions, and please use caution when smoking at all times.
- Please pick up all manure and hay in the parking area.
- Protect trails. Riding during wet weather is not encouraged.
- Please park vehicles so gates, roads and parking areas are not blocked.
